ANNUAL REPORT OF CRC TRIPURA 2017-2018

INTRODUCTION:

Composite Regional Centre (CRC), Tripura under the administrative control of National Institute for Locomotor Disabilities (NILD), Kolkata, has been established for the Rehabilitation of Persons with Disabilities in the state of Tripura, by the Ministry of Social Justice & Empowerment, under the Persons with Disabilities Act (Equal Opportunities, Protection of Rights and full participation) in the Year November 2017, at Narsingarh, Tripura West. Presently, the center is functioning in the allotted building provided by Social Welfare and Social Education Department in the premises of Juvenile Home, Narsingarh, Agartala.

OBJECTIVES of CRC - TRIPURA:

CRC TRIPURA, at its inception itself had projected multifarious activities to enhance the quality of life of persons with disabilities. Accordingly, the main objective of CRC has been identified as follows:

- 1. To serve as Resource Centre for rehabilitation and special education of persons with disabilities.
- 2. To undertake human resource development by training rehabilitation professionals, village level workers, multi-rehabilitation workers and other functionaries in Govt. and non-Govt. sector, required for providing services to persons with disabilities.
- 3. To undertake public education programs for creation of awareness in the parents and the community.
- 4. To undertake designing, fabrication and fitment of aids and appliances.
- 5. To undertake services of education and skill development leading to enhancement of opportunities for employment, rehabilitation, mobility communication recreation and integration in society.
- 6. To undertake research and development with specific reference to needs of diverse groups of people with disability, keeping in view the nature and severity of disability in the region.
- 7. To develop strategies for delivery of rehabilitation services suitable to the socio-cultural background of the region.
- 8. To stimulate growth of services by encouraging and supporting voluntary organization, parent groups and self-help groups.
- 9. To establish linkages with existing medical, educational and employment services, following the principles of community-based rehabilitation and offer extension services in the rural areas.

VISION OF CRC TRIPURA: -

To promote the rights and well-being of persons with disabilities in all spheres of society and development, and to increase awareness of the situation of persons with disabilities in every aspect of physical, political, social, economic and cultural life.

MISSION OF CRC TRIPURA: -

The mission of the CRC Tripura is to develop human resources for providing rehabilitation services to people with disabilities in all aspect of physical, mental, cognitive and social impairment.

PROGRAMS ORGANIZED BY THE CRC - TRIPURA THROUGHOUT THIS YEAR: -

❖ Celebration of International Day of Persons with Disabilities (Divyangjan) –

The first ever program of CRC -Tripura was conducted with the Juvenile of Home. Narsingarh in the occasion of celebration "INTERNATIONAL DAY OF PERSONS WITH DISBILITIES" on 5th December, 2017. In this program, the staff of this center was elaborately discussed about the Disability (Divyangian) in front the staff of Juvenile Home to cater awareness on disability. - ❖ This center also started providing client services in terms of assessment and evaluation, therapy implementation, counseling and home exercise program for the betterment of the life of PWDs. Detailed information starting from Patient registration, demographic data, diagnosis, contact no are being entered to maintain proper documentation and evidence for the center.
- ❖ The Tripura State Electricity Corporation Ltd. also installed the Electric Sub-Transformer in our office campus and also given us the Electric Connection with installing the Electric Meter.
- ❖ The Occupational Therapy and Prosthetist & Orthotist units are started to give their services to visited patients to our center.
- ❖ In this year, this center was received various types of machineries and equipments for the betterment of PwDs for the various units of this center.
- Necessary registers and files are opened to maintain the records of this center.
- ❖ In this year other than the CRC Staff, newly 5 Nos. of Outsourcing Staffs are also joined in our Center.
- ❖ Also communicate with the local Panchayat Pradhan for cleanliness of entrance of our Center.
- ❖ In mind of Swattcha Bharat, the Center's staff are also carried out some activities to clean the Office Surface and created a Garden in front of the Center Complex.
