INTRODUCTION:

Composite Regional Centre for Skill Development, Rehabilitation and Empowerment of Persons with Disabilities, Tripura under the administrative control of National Institute for Locomotor Disabilities (NILD), Kolkata, has been established for the Rehabilitation of Persons with Disabilities in the state of Tripura, by the Ministry of Social Justice & Empowerment, under the Persons with Disabilities Act (Equal Opportunities, Protection of Rights and full participation) in the Year November 2017, at Narsingarh, Tripura West. At present, the centre is functioning in the allotted building provided by Department of Social Welfare and Social Education in the premises of Juvenile Home, Narsingarh, Agartala.

OBJECTIVES of CRC - TRIPURA:

CRC TRIPURA, at its inception itself had projected multifarious activities to enhance the quality of life of persons with disabilities. Accordingly, the main objective of CRC has been identified as follows:

- 1. To serve as Resource Centre for rehabilitation and special education of persons with disabilities.
- 2. To undertake human resource development by training rehabilitation professionals, village level workers, multi-rehabilitation workers and other functionaries in Govt. and non-Govt. sector, required for providing services to persons with disabilities.
- 3. To undertake public education programs for creation of awareness in the parents and the community.
- 4. To undertake designing, fabrication and fitment of aids and appliances.
- 5. To undertake services of education and skill development leading to enhancement of opportunities for employment, rehabilitation, mobility communication recreation and integration in society.
- 6. To undertake research and development with specific reference to needs of diverse groups of people with disability, keeping in view the nature and severity of disability in the region.
- 7. To develop strategies for delivery of rehabilitation services suitable to the socio-cultural background of the region.
- 8. To stimulate growth of services by encouraging and supporting voluntary organization, parent groups and self-help groups.
- 9. To establish linkages with existing medical, educational and employment services, following the principles of community-based rehabilitation and offer extension services in the rural areas.

VISION OF CRC TRIPURA: -

To promote the rights and well-being of persons with disabilities in all spheres of society and development, and to increase awareness of the situation of persons with disabilities in every aspect of physical, political, social, economic and cultural life.

MISSION OF CRC TRIPURA: -

The mission of the CRC Tripura is through constant professional endeavors, empowering the person with disability to access the state of the habilitation intervention viz. educational therapeutic vocational, employment, leisure and social sports and cultural programmers and full participation.

FORTHCOMING GOALS OF CRC TRIPURA

A. COURSES

CRC-Tripura is planning to conduct the following courses in the upcoming academic session. The details are as follows:-

- I. D. Ed (SE MR): The duration of the course is of 2 years and the intake capacity is 25 persons per year.
- II. Diploma in Indian Sign Language Interpretation: The duration of the course is of 2 years and the intake capacity is 15 persons per year.

B. SKILL DEVELOPMENT PROGRAMME

Starting Skill Development Training Programs for the Persons with Disabilities is a one of the prime goal of CRC – Tripura in this year.

PROGRAMS ORGANIZED BY THE CRC – TRIPURA THROUGHOUT THE YEAR

❖ INAUGURAL PROGRAM OF CRC-TRIPURA

On the 8th Day of June, 2018 CRC was officially inaugurated in presence of Shri Thaawarchand Gehlot, Hon'ble Union Minister for Social Justice and Empowerment, Govt. of India, Shri Biplab Kumar Deb, Hon'ble Chief Minister, Govt. of Tripura, Smt. Santana Chakma, Hon'ble Minister for Dept. of Social Welfare and Social Education, Govt. of Tripura, Smt. Dolly Chakraborty, Joint Secretary, DEPwD, Govt. of India. Besides, Shri Shankar Prasad Datta, MP from Tripura and Shri Krishnadhan Das, MLA, Bamutia Constituency, Govt. of Tripura and other dignitaries were also present to grace the occasion.



❖ CELEBRATION OF INDEPENDENCE DAY AT CRC-TRIPURA

The first ever celebration of Independence Day was successfully organized by CRC Tripura on 15th August, 2018. The tri-colour was hosted at around 8 AM by Sri Partha Bhattacharya (a child with special needs) handed by Sri Rajiv Kr. Ghosh (I/C CRC-Tripura) in presence of all the CRC staffs, Juvenile home staff & few children of Narsingarh high school.



❖ CELEBRATION OF INTERNATIONAL DAY OF PERSONS WITH DISABILITIES

On the 3rd of December, 2018, the Celebration of "INTERNATIONAL DAY OF **PERSONS** WITH DISBILITIES" successfully was conducted by the CRC - Tripura. The employees of CRC - Tripura have shown immense desire to celebrate the said program with the Children with Needs(CwSN).The Special children along with their Parents participated in the program. Total of 55 numbers of



participants including PwDs, Community members, Guardians and 15 numbers of Children with Special Needs along with their parents participated in this program. The program was followed by the participation the Divyangjan children in different activities viz. making of collages, filling in colours in sketches and throwing of balls in basket and finally prizes were distributed amongst the participants.

❖ REPUBLIC DAY CELEBRATION

The first ever celebration of Republic day was successfully organized by CRC-Tripura on the 26th January, 2019. The tri-color was hosted by Shri Rajesh Kumar Singh, Director CRC-Tripura in presence of all the staffs of CRC, Juvenile home staffs & few children of Narsingarh high school. Following that, the National Anthem was sung and patriotic slogans were being raised to show love and respect for our Country.



❖ Training Program on Indian Sign Language: -

The SIPARD conducted a 15 days training program on Indian Sign Language for the teachers of School Education Dept. on the request of Social Welfare & Social Education Dept., Govt. of Tripura from 14th to 28th March, 2018. The Director, CRC-Tripura participated in the said program as a resource person and decided the topics which were to be taught in the program.

❖ ONE DAY SESTIZATION-CUM-AWARENESS PROGRAMS

In the year of 2018-19 many awareness-cum-sensitization programs has been conducted with the anganwadi and the asha workers. The details of the same are listed below:-

- 1. May, 2018:- An One Day Sensitization Program with the topic of "Disability, Rehabilitation and RPWD Act 2016" was successfully conducted by CRC Tripura under NILD Kolkata on 8th May, 2018 at Belonia for PWDs, Guardian, Community members, ASHA Workers and Anganwadi Workers. Around 164 nos. of participants are took part in this program.
- **2. August, 2018:-** On the 31st August, 2018, a one day One Day Sensitization Program with the topic of "Disability, Rehabilitation and RPWD Act 2016" was successfully conducted by CRC Tripura with ASHA and Anganwadi at Boxanagar, Sipahijala District. In this Program 101 Nos. of Participants took part in the said program including the staffs of CDPO Office.
- **3. September, 2018:-** On 20th September 2018 a One Day Sensitization Program with the topic of "Disability, Rehabilitation and RPWD Act 2016" was successfully conducted by CRC Tripura with ASHA, Anganwadi Workers, Panchayat Functionaries and Community Members at Shantirbazar, South Tripura District. In this Program 131 Nos. of Participants did participate in the program.
- **4. December, 2018:-** On the 26th December, 2018 a one day Sensitization Program with the topic of "Disability, Rehabilitation and RPwD Act 2016" was successfully conducted by CRC Tripura with ASHA, Anganwadi Workers, Panchayat Functionaries and Community Members at Udaipur, Gomati District, Tripura. In this Program 100 Nos. of Participants participated
- **5. January, 2019 :-** On 4th January, 2019 a one day One Day Sensitization Program with the topic of "Disability, Rehabilitation and RPwD Act 2016" was successfully conducted by CRC Tripura with Anganwadi Workers, Panchayat Functionaries and Community Members at Jirania Panchayat Samiti Hall, Jirania R. D. Block, West Tripura District. In this Program 100 Nos. of Participants took part.
- **6. February, 2019:-** On 26th February, 2019 a One Day Sensitization Program on the title 'Disability, Rehabilitation and RPwD Act, 2016' was held at Dukli which is in the West District of Tripura. The program was held in the Dukli Panchayat Samiti Hall and where the participants included the Anganwadi Workers, Panchayat Functionaries and Community Members from the area of Dukli ICDS Project & Dukli Panchayat Samiti.

* IDENTIFICATION & DISTRIBUTION CAMPS UNDER ADIP SCHEME:-

- 1. On the 8th May, 2018 an identification camp with the title of "Identification camp for the needs of Aids and Appliances" was done for 98 Nos. of beneficiaries at Belonia.
- 2. On 9th May 2018 an "Identification camp for the needs of Aids and Appliances" was done by CRC Tripura under NILD Kolkata at Barjala, Agartala for 107 Nos. of beneficiaries.
- **3.** On 26th September 2018, a Distribution camp for the needs of Aids and Appliances was being held on Belonia, South Tripura and total 21 Nos. of Aids and Appliances has been distributed.
- **4.** On 28th September 2018 & 01st October, 2018, a Distribution camp for the needs of Aids and Appliances was being held on Charilam, Sepahijala District and total 10 Nos. of Aids and Appliances has been distributed.
- **5.** On 10th January, 2019 a Distribution Camp was successfully carried out at Teliamura, Khowai District of Tripura. In this camp, total of 11 nos. of different aids and appliances were distributed.
- **6.** On 13th February, 2019 a distribution camp was held at Belonia in collaboration with ORS, Belonia and in this camp 30 (thirty) nos. of Hearing aids and 1 (One) no. of White Cane was distributed.
- 7. On 31th January, 2019 6 nos. of hearing aids were distributed from CRC-Tripura.

- Swachh Bharat mission was celebrated by CRC Tripura from 14th April to 28th April by washing and cleaning of indoor and outdoor complex of office along with tree plantation in the garden by the staffs of CRC-Tripura.
- ❖ On 17th June, 2018, All India CET Exam for admission to the courses of BOT, BPT & BPO was successfully conducted by the CRC − Tripura.
- ❖ In this financial year i.e. 2018-2019 5 (Five) new employees have been appointed in addition to the existing 7 (Seven) other employees of CRC − Tripura.
- ❖ On 26th January, 2019 the Dy. Commissioner for PwDs, Govt. of Tripura and Dy. Director, Dept. of Social Welfare & Social Education, Govt. of Tripura visited to the centre.
- An awareness program was conducted by the Rehabilitation Officer and Assistant Professor (Special Education), CRC-Tripura on the 15th March, 2019 on "Child with Special Educational Needs: Identification and Classroom Management" at Sukhomoy H. S. School, Ushabazar for the teachers. Lectures on Identification and Management of Children with Various Disabilities were delivered.






