INTRODUCTION:

Composite Regional Centre for Skill Development, Rehabilitation and Empowerment of Persons with Disabilities, Tripura under the administrative control of National Institute for Locomotor Disabilities (NILD), Kolkata, has been established for the Rehabilitation of Persons with Disabilities in the state of Tripura, by the Department of Empowerment of Persons with Disabilities, Ministry of Social Justice & Empowerment, Govt. of India in the Year November 2017, at Narsingarh, Tripura West. At present, the centre is functioning in the allotted building provided by Department of Social Welfare and Social Education in the premises of Juvenile Home, Narsingarh, Agartala.

OBJECTIVES OF CRC SRE - TRIPURA :

The main objectives of CRC SRE, Tripura are as follows:

1. To serve as Resource Centre for rehabilitation and special education of persons with disabilities.
2. To undertake human resource development by training rehabilitation professionals, village level workers, multi -rehabilitation workers and other functionaries in Govt. and non-Govt. sector, required for providing services to persons with disabilities.
3. To undertake public education programs for creation of awareness in the parents and the community.
4. To undertake designing, fabrication and fitment of Prosthesis, Orthosis, Mobility aids and other assistive devices.
5. To undertake services of education and skill development leading to enhancement of opportunities for employment, rehabilitation, mobility communication recreation and integration in society.
6. To undertake research and development with specific reference to needs of diverse groups of people with disability, keeping in view the nature and severity of disability in the region.
7. To develop strategies for delivery of rehabilitation services suitable to the socio-cultural background of the region.
8. To stimulate growth of services by encouraging and supporting voluntary organization, parent groups and self-help groups.
9. To establish linkages with existing medical, educational and employment services, following the principles of community-based rehabilitation and offer extension services in the rural areas.

VISION OF CRC SRE, TRIPURA

To promote the rights and well-being of persons with disabilities in all spheres of society and development, and to increase awareness of the situation of persons with disabilities in every aspect of physical, social, economic, political, and cultural life.

MISSION OF CRC SRE, TRIPURA

The mission of the CRCSRE, Tripura is through constant professional endeavors, empowering the person with disability to access the state of the rehabilitation intervention viz. educational, therapeutic, vocational, employment, leisure and social sports and cultural programmes and full participation.

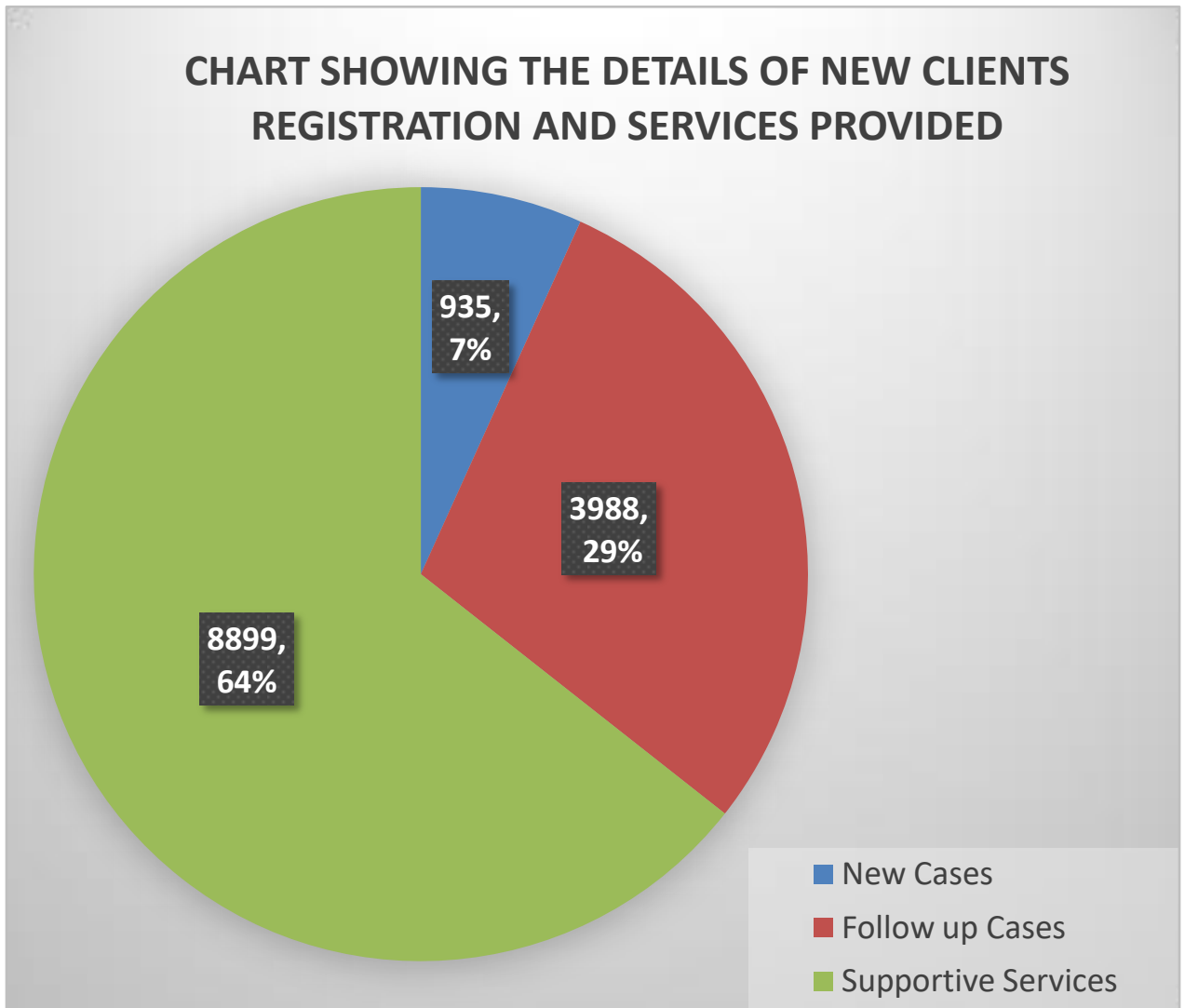
C. CONDUCTING A NATIONAL LEVEL CONFERENCE ON INDIAN ACADEMY OF CEREBRAL PALSY

CHART SHOWING THE DETAILS OF FOLLOW UP & SUPPORTIVE SERVICES PROVIDED DURING 2019-2020

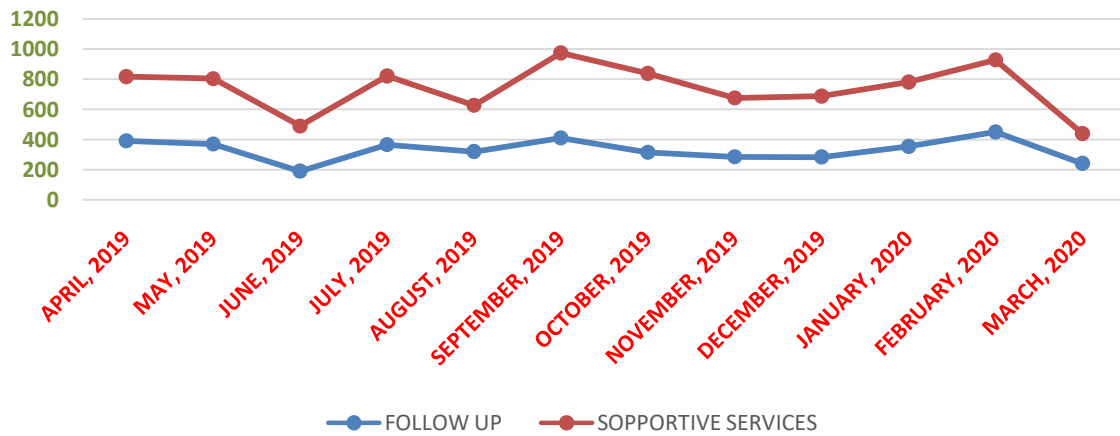
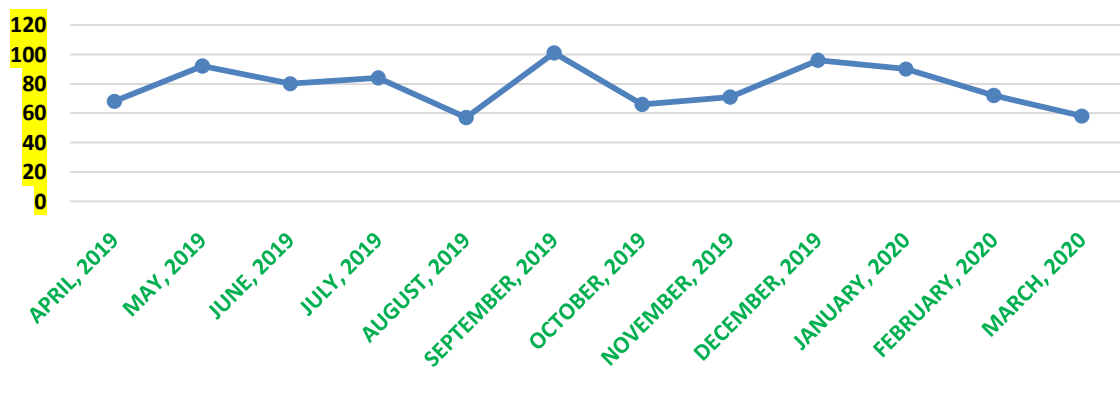


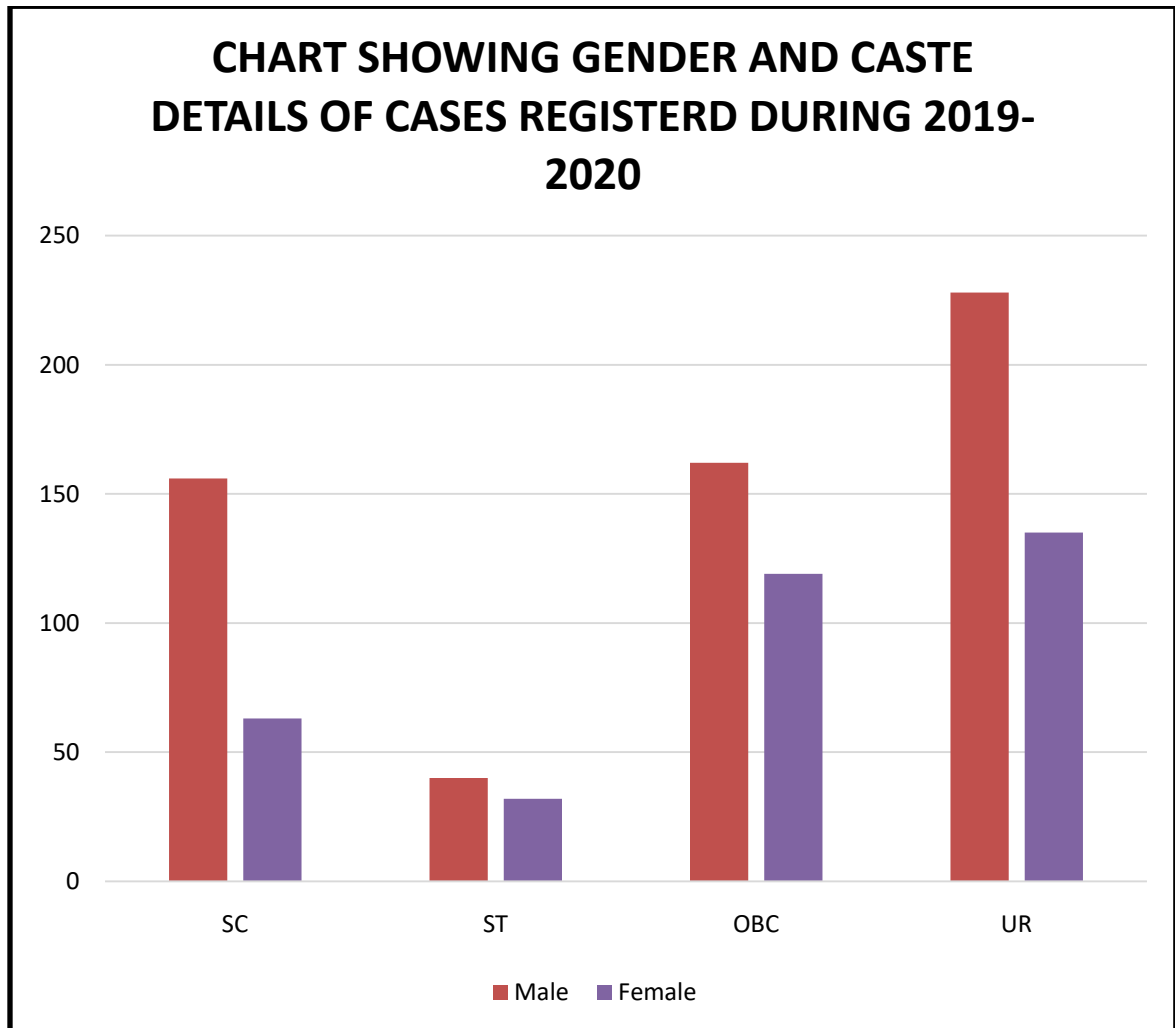
CHART SHOWING THE DETAILS OF MONTH WISE NEW CASE REGISTRATION

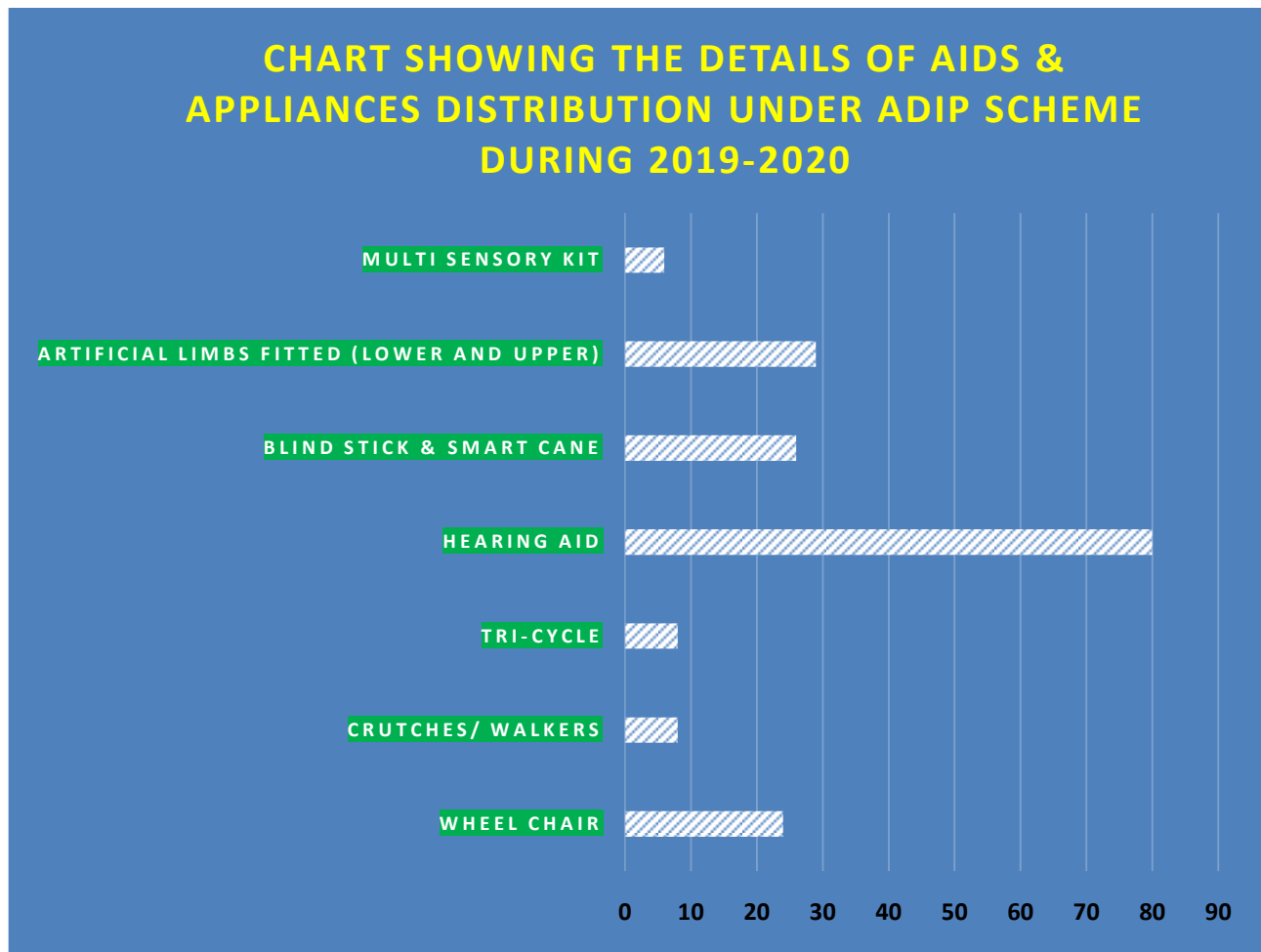

FROM OPD SERVICES OF CENTRE IN 2019-20**

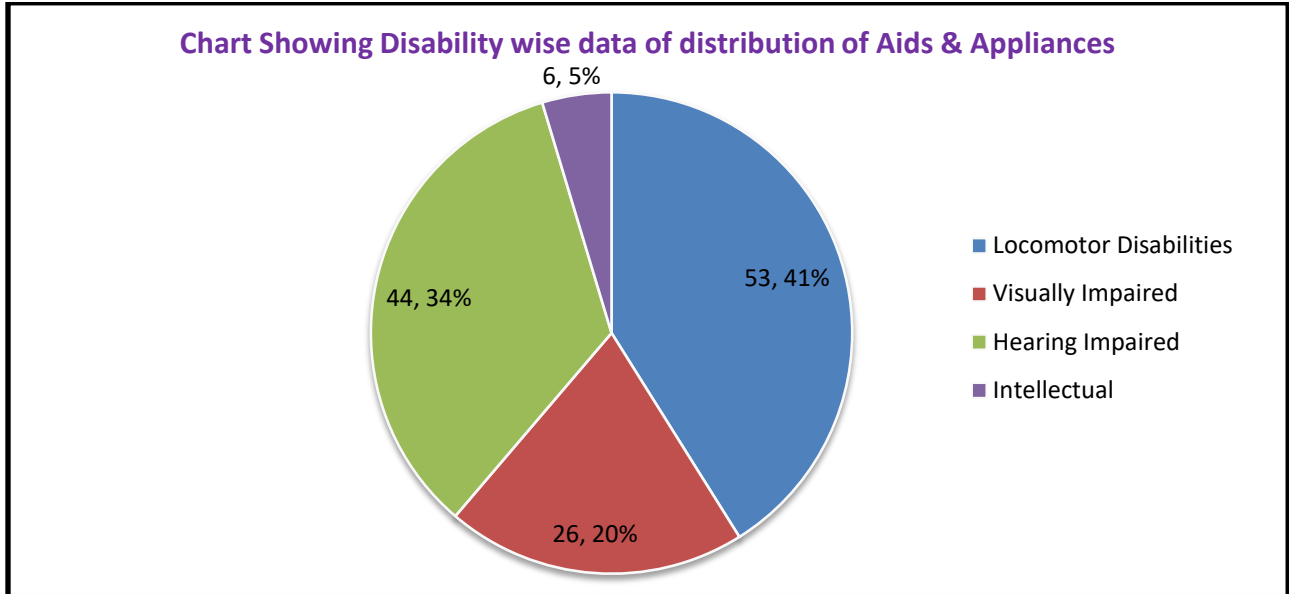

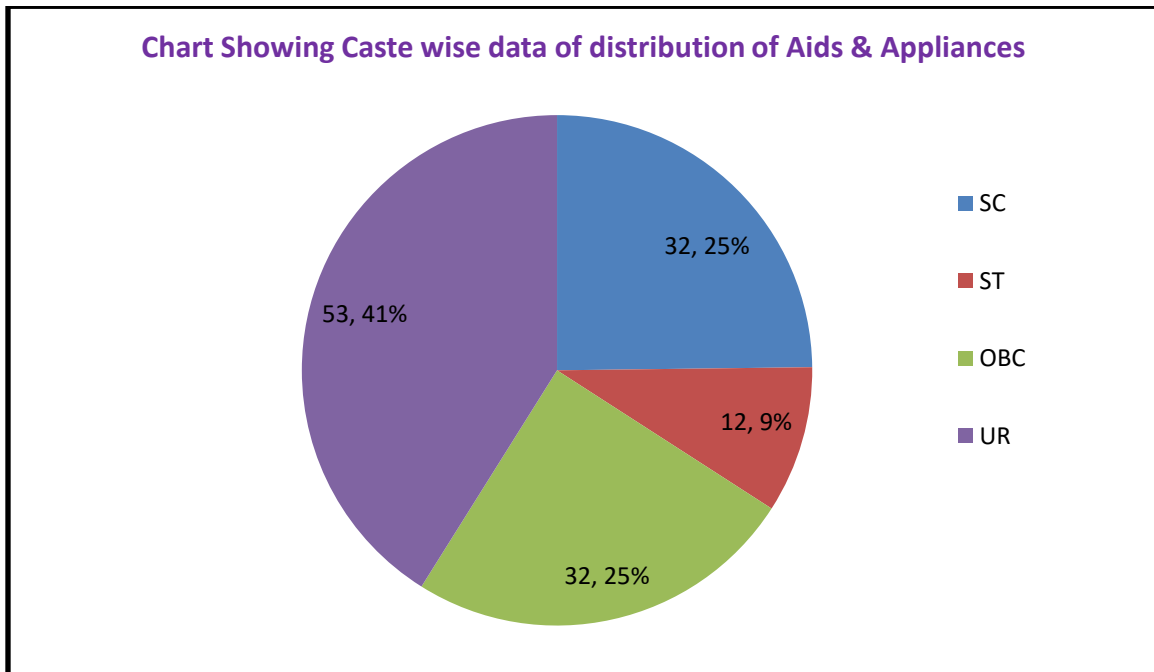

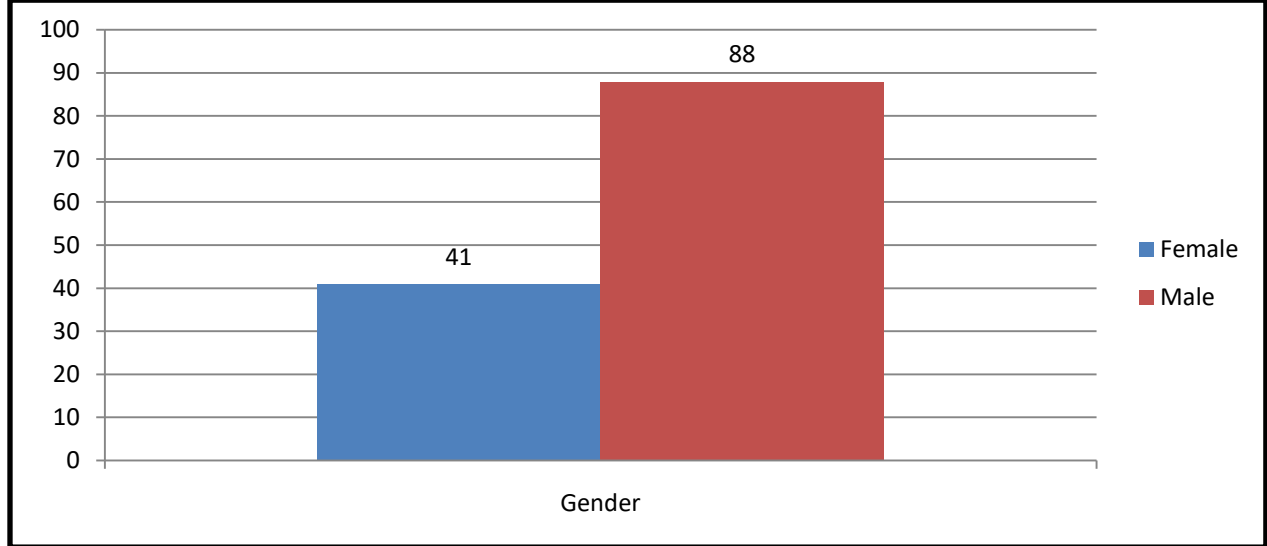

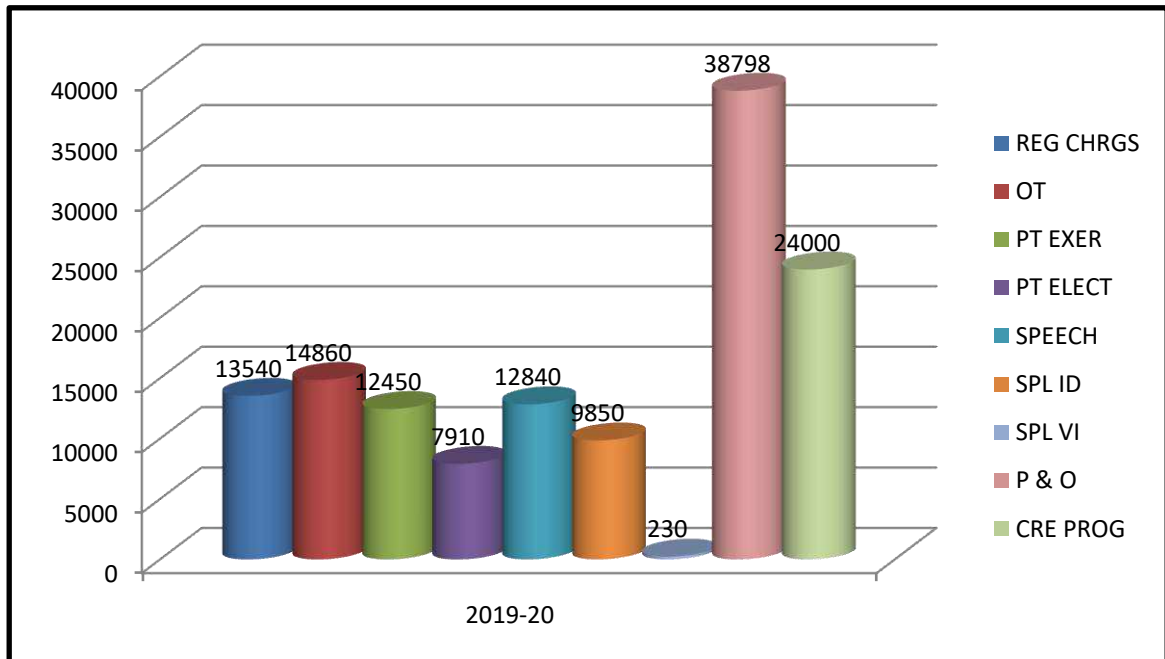

DETAILS OF OUT-REACH ACTIVITIES CARRIED-OUT THROUGHOUT THIS YEAR

❖ **One Day Sensitization-cum-Awareness Programs conducted by CRC SRE – Tripura in 2019-20: -**

In the year of 2019-20 many awareness-cum-sensitization programs has been conducted with the Anganwadi and the ASHA workers. The details of the same are listed for the below mentioned months:-

1. May, 2019:-

- (i) A One Day Sensitization Program in the topic “Disability, Rehabilitation Program on Disability, Rehabilitation & RPWD Act., 2016” was successfully conducted by CRC SRE, Tripura on 28th May, 2019 at Kathalia, Sepahijala District of Tripura for Anganwadi workers and community members of Kathalia R.D. Block. In total **102 nos.** of people participated in the programme.
- (ii) A One Day Sensitization Program in the topic “Disability, Rehabilitation Program on Disability, Rehabilitation & RPWD Act., 2016” was successfully conducted by CRC SRE, Tripura on 31st May, 2019 at Mandai, Jirania for Anganwadi workers and community members of Mandai R.D. Block. In **total 101 nos.** of people participated in the programme.

2. June, 2019:-

- (i) A One Day Sensitization Program in the topic “Disability, Rehabilitation Program on Disability, Rehabilitation & RPWD Act., 2016” was successfully conducted by CRC SRE, Tripura on 26th June, 2019 at Panisagar, North District of Tripura for Anganwadi workers and community members of Panisagar R.D. Block. In total **105 nos.** of people participated in the programme.

- (ii) A One Day Sensitization Program in the topic “Disability, Rehabilitation Program on Disability, Rehabilitation & RPWD Act., 2016” was successfully conducted by CRC SRE, Tripura on 27th June, 2019 at Kumarghat, Unakoti District of Tripura for Anganwadi workers and community members of Kumarghat R.D. Block. In total **100 nos.** of people participated in the programme.

3. November, 2019:-

Total 11 Nos. of One Day Sensitization-cum-Awareness Programs were conducted in this year and a total 1,750 Nos. of Beneficiaries were participated in these programs.



❖ **Identification cum Assessment Camps under ADIP Scheme conducted by CRC SRE – Tripura in 2019-20 : -**

In the year of 2019-20 many Identification cum Assessment camps under ADIP Scheme has been conducted by CRC SRE, Tripura.

The details of the same are listed for the below mentioned months:-

- 1. June, 2019:-**A One Day Identification Camp for the needs of Aids & Appliances under ADIP Scheme was organized on 28th June, 2019 at Pecharthal R.D. Block, North District of Tripura. In this camp 300 nos. of people participated.
- 2. September, 2019:-** A One Day Identification cum Assessment Camp was organized at Rupaichari R.D. Block, South District of Tripura on 9th September, 2019 with the help of local Administration of Govt. of Tripura. In the camp, a total number of 67 clients were registered and a total of 39 clients were identified.
- 3. November, 2019:-**A One day Identification Camp for the Need of Aids & Appliances were held at Bamutia, West District of Tripura on the 29th November, 2019. In this camp 93 nos. of people participated.
- 4. December, 2019: -** A one day hearing screening-cum-awareness camp was conducted on 8th December, 2019 at SP Traffic Office campus for traffic police personnel. A total of 39 Nos. of Traffic Police were screened through Audiometric Test.

Total 4 Nos. of Identification cum Assessment Camps under ADIP Scheme were conducted in this year and a total 499 Nos. of Beneficiaries were participated in these Camps.

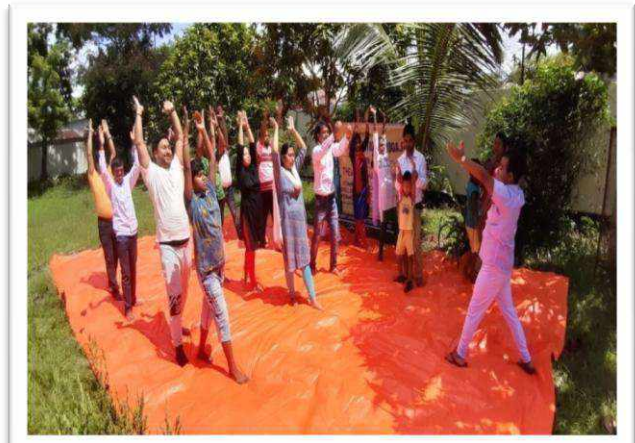
